WHAT TO EXPECT

When a Therapist has reviewed your referral, you will receive a text message to note if your referral has been accepted and requesting you to contact to book a telephone or video screening assessment appointment.

A Speech and Language Therapist will contact you on the agreed date and time to:

- Listen to you and discuss your concerns
- Ask questions to assess the needs of your child
- Observe your child in play (via pre-sent videos or video link)
- Talk with you about ideas to help your child

AFTER THIS, THE SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPIST:

- May ask for videos to be sent or to call you via video link.
- May offer a further appointment
- May suggest that you contact her after a time to let her know how your child is doing.
